A short drive, you will find yourself at the feet of the fascinating statue of the Sphinx. The largest monolith sculpture in Ancient Egypt. This mysterious monument was carved to symbolize the pharaoh's power and wisdom. On the way to the museum, you will stop at the papyrus institute to see how this ancient genuine artwork was produced in the old times. Your next stop will be the Egyptian museum. This museum [opened in 1901} has the largest collection of artifacts in the world. A visit to this museum is a must. With your guide, you will find yourself diving into a sea of 165,000 artifacts and antiquities. Your guide will explain and show you the highlights and most important the pieces. Mainly, the treasures of the young pharaoh Tut Ankh Amun, His golden mask and coffins, and the contents of his intact tomb. You will enjoy looking at the fantastic sculptures, sarcophagi, jewelry, and papyrus scrolls that date back to different eras. The third place to visit is Khan El Khalili Bazar. Explore one of the oldest bazaars in the middle east.it is an interesting, lively, and busy place where you can try your bargaining skills.
