tour.overview

Most total eclipses give you two minutes. This one gives you more than six — the longest totality visible from land this century, and the path runs directly over Upper Egypt. Totality is not a darker version of a partial eclipse. It is a different event. The temperature drops several degrees in a few minutes, the light goes the colour of old silver, birds settle, and the horizon glows sunset-orange in every direction at once. Then the corona appears — the sun's outer atmosphere, invisible on every other day of your life — and stays there long enough that you stop taking photographs and simply look. You watch it from an approved viewing site on the Nile, reached by private transfer from the boat rather than by coach convoy from a hotel. ISO-certified solar viewing glasses, shaded seating, cold drinks and an Egyptologist who will tell you exactly what the ancient Egyptians made of a vanishing sun are all part of the day.

Day 1

July 30th, 2027: Cairo, Arrival

You will be warmly met and assisted upon arrival at Cairo International Airport by our dedicated representative, then transferred in a private, air-conditioned van to an Airport hotel in Cairo, where you will recover from the jet lag and your unforgettable journey begins.

Day 2

July 31st, 2027: Head to Luxor – East Bank

Today, you will take an afternoon flight to Luxor, where you will be warmly met and assisted by our representative upon arrival. You will then be transferred to your Dahabiya where your journey will continue aboard your luxurious Dahabiya for the next 6 days and 5 nights

Later, your Egyptologist guide will escort you to the Karnak Temple Complex, the largest religious structure ever constructed. Known in ancient times as Ipet-isut, or “the Most Sacred of Places,” this awe-inspiring complex was built over more than 2,000 years by successive generations of pharaohs.

Your journey continues with a visit to the beautifully illuminated Luxor Temple. It was built by Amenhotep III and Ramses II, this temple was once the setting for grand rituals and festivals, dedicated to the god Amun. As it's surrounded by ancient grandeur, your immersion into Egypt's royal past has truly begun!

Day 3

August 1st, 2027: Luxor West Bank

After your breakfast, you will head to the West Bank of the Nile to behold the awe-inspiring Colossi of Memnon, two monumental statues that have stood the test of time. We continue to the Valley of the Kings, the sacred necropolis where the magnificent tombs of pharaohs lie hidden beneath the desert sands. Here, you will have the unique opportunity to visit the tomb of King Tutankhamen (optional, at an additional cost), one of Egypt's most famous and fascinating discoveries.

Next, you will explore the Temple of Hatshepsut at El Deir El Bahari, an architectural masterpiece dedicated to Egypt's powerful female pharaoh.

Day 4

August 2nd, 2027: Solar Eclipse Day

Today is the day of the solar eclipse. You will enjoy a hearty breakfast and some time to relax before heading to the main event. We will head to the approved solar eclipse viewing site around midday. There, you'll witness the incredible moment as the moon covers the sun for around six minutes and twenty-two seconds! You'll experience this rare and awe-inspiring phenomenon alongside fellow eclipse enthusiasts.

Please make sure to wear light, breathable clothing, as the weather can be quite hot, and don't forget to bring your solar viewing glasses to safely enjoy the eclipse. After the event, you'll return to Dahabiya to relax and reflect on the experience.

Day 5

August 3rd, 2027: Luxor– Sail to Edfu

After a leisurely breakfast, your Dahabiya as it sets sail towards Edfu, where you will explore the remarkably well-preserved Temple of Horus, celebrated as one of Egypt's most exquisite and iconic temples.

Day 6

August 4th, 2027: Herdiab Island
