Day 1

Giza | Sakkara | Memphis

Once you arrive at Cairo Airport, your guide will meet you to start your tour with the visit to the pyramids of Egypt. It is a childhood dream for millions of people in this world, especially for those who studied about them when they were little kids. With Your Egypt Tours, you will visit the Giza pyramids and Sphinx, the Step pyramid of Sakkara, and a visit to the ancient capital of Memphis. Discover the magic of Giza city on a day tour and explore the famous Giza pyramids area and Sphinx. You will start visiting the symbol of the Eternity and the only wonder that still survives among the seven wonders of the ancient world, the Great Pyramid of Cheops(Khufu). It is certainly one of the most important monuments of ancient Egypt. A masterpiece of fabricated structure and architecture, you will be overwhelmed by the huge size of its blocks, the height, and the age that exceeded 4600 years. While you stare at this great monument, your guide will explain fully the history of the area including the other pyramids, of Chephren and Mycerinus, answer all your questions and give you free time for photography. You will have the chance to take pictures of the area including all the pyramids from the panorama area.). You will spend more than two hours in the area so that you can have enough time to do some extras like entering one of the pyramid's chambers and visiting the Sun boat museum. (All upon your request for an extra cost). You may like to have fun and explore the edge of the desert by having a camel ride around the area. (For extra cost). Moving to the Sphinx area where you will spend some time exploring this monolith statue, which symbolizes the power and wisdom of the pharaoh as the statue, was carved as a lion's body and the head of the pharaoh. Next to the Sphinx area, you will visit the valley temple where you will learn about mummification in ancient Egypt. The next stop will be at Sakkara, another great archeological site where the famous and multi-titled architect Imhotep built the oldest pyramid in Egypt. The first stone structure is 4800 years and was erected in the form of huge

solid steps on top of each. (The name Step Pyramid is quite suitable). Your tour guide will accompany you inside one of the tombs of the nobles (tomb of Kagmini) to see murals reflecting daily life activities in ancient Egypt. Memphis is your third destination to visit the open-air museum in the city. In Memphis, you will see the second-largest Sphinx in Egypt, the lying colossus of Ramses II, and many more monuments dug in this great city. Since the itinerary for the private tour is completely flexible, we can accommodate any special requests. You can spend as much time as you like at each site without being rushed. Day 2

the Grand Egyptian Museum – A Journey Through Ancient Treasures

Begin your day with a guided visit to the world-famous **Grand Egyptian Museum**, home to one of the most extensive collections of ancient Egyptian artifacts. Housing tens of thousands of pieces, the museum offers a journey through Egypt's long and fascinating history.

With your Egyptologist guide, focus on the **most important highlights and masterpieces** spread across its various halls.

Visit the **Tutankhamun Wing** on the first floor, showcasing his magnificent treasures. This extraordinary collection—dominated by gold artifacts, statues, furniture, and funerary objects—occupies a significant section of the museum and represents one of the greatest archaeological discoveries in

history.

After the guided tour, enjoy some **free time** to explore at your own pace.

Old Coptic Cairo – A Sacred Heritage

Continue your tour with a visit to **Coptic Cairo**, one of the most spiritual and historically rich districts in the city. This sacred quarter is home to 14 churches and a historic Jewish synagogue, reflecting Egypt's deep religious heritage and tolerance.

Begin at the **Hanging Church**, dating back to the 5th century and dedicated to the Virgin Mary. Built over one of the towers of the Roman fortress of Babylon, this church is renowned for its 110 exquisite icons and once served as the seat of the Patriarch.

Next, visit the **Church of St. Sergius and Bacchus (Abu Serga)**, also known as the Cavern Church. This sacred site is believed to be where the Holy Family—Virgin Mary, Joseph, and the infant Jesus—took refuge for three months during their flight into Egypt. Thousands of pilgrims come here every year to connect with this remarkable biblical history.

Conclude your exploration with a stop at the **Ben Ezra Synagogue**, Cairo's oldest Jewish temple. Named after a Jerusalem merchant, this synagogue stands as a symbol of Egypt's religious diversity and was once the center of a thriving Jewish community.

Return to Hurghada

At the end of this enriching cultural and spiritual journey, you will be

transferred to the airport for your **flight back to Hurghada**.
