Consider the intricate carvings and immerse yourself in this sacred site's rich history. Next, explore The High Dam, an engineering marvel that has shaped the course of the Nile.

After a day filled with historical wonders, stroll comfortably through the vibrant Aswan Bazaar and enjoy a delicious lunch.

We continue sailing to Kom Ombo, with its tranquil scenery, and overnight there.

Day 2

Kom Ombo

As we reach Kom Ombo, you'll step onto land to explore the Greco-Roman Temple—a testament to ancient architectural precision; the temple boasts total symmetry with two entrances, halls, and sanctuaries dedicated to the Falcon God Haroeris (Horus the Elder) and the Crocodile God Sobek. Prepare to be amazed as we tie up alongside the Speos of Horemheb. This ancient rock-cut temple is tucked away along the river. If the conditions permit, the dinner there

will be a truly enchanting experience, or enjoy it on the upper deck of the Dahabiya Nile Boat.

Day 3

Edfu
