Day 1

Aswan (High Dam, Unfinished Obelisk & Philae Temple)

Embark your Nile cruise with a visit to the impressive High Dam, followed by a visit to the [Unfinished Obelisk](#) and the picturesque [Philae Temple](#).

Embark on the Nile cruise before lunch, and enjoy a serene felucca ride to the Botanical Gardens in the afternoon.

Day 2

Kom Ombo Temple & Edfu

Sail to Kom Ombo and explore the unique Kom Ombo Temple, dedicated to two gods ([Sobek and Horus](#)). Sail further to Edfu and visit the well-preserved Temple of Horus, one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt. Sail towards Luxor.

Day 3

Luxor (West Bank & East Bank)

Unveil the treasures of Luxor after a delicious breakfast on board The Nile Cruise as you visit Luxor (West and East Bank).

The West Bank includes the [Valley of the Kings](#), the Temple of [Queen Hatshepsut](#), and the towering [Colossi of Memnon](#).

On the East Bank, explore the grand [Karnak](#) and Luxor Temples, adorned with stunning columns and statues.

Optional Night Activity:

Join an optional Sound and Light Show at Karnak for an additional USD 45.00 per person.

Day 4

Hot Air Balloon ride

Embark on an awe-inspiring hot air balloon ride over the West Bank, offering a bird's-eye view of the ancient landmarks and the breathtaking landscape (additional cost of USD 99.00 per person).
