Dendera Temple Complex

Ptolemaic-Roman masterpiece (2250-343 BC), Dedicated to **Hathor**, goddess of joy and love.

The Dendera Zodiac (ancient celestial map)

Hathor-headed columns with intact paint

Secret crypts with esoteric symbolism

Evening:

Scenic drive to Luxor along the Nile.

Check into your **5-star luxury hotel**.

Overnight: Luxor

Day 7

Nile Cruise Begins – Luxor's Temple Treasures

Colossi of Memnon

18m tall guardians of Amenhotep III's lost temple.

Hear the legend of the “**singing statues**” (Roman-era phenomenon).

Return to ship for **lunch while sailing to Edfu**.

Evening:

Gourmet dinner onboard.

Optional: **Galabeya party** with traditional music.

Overnight: Sailing to Edfu

Day 9

Falcon Warriors & Crocodile Kings

Horse-drawn carriage ride through the town to the temple.

Edfu Temple (237-57 BC)

Best-preserved Ptolemaic temple in Egypt.

Dedicated to **Horus the Avenger**.

Horus statue with double crown

Sanctuary's granite shrine (where the god's statue resided)

Dramatic reliefs of Horus defeating Seth

Midday:

Return to ship for **lunch while sailing to Kom Ombo**.

Kom Ombo Temple (180-47 BC)

Only dual temple in Egypt (split down the middle).

Twin sanctuaries for:

Sobek (crocodile god of fertility)

Haroeris (falcon-headed sky healer)

Discover:

Ancient surgical tools carved on walls

Crocodile mummy museum

Nilometer with precise markings

Evening:

Sunset sailing toward Aswan.

Dinner with Nubian-inspired dishes.

Overnight: Docked in Aswan

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 10

Abu Simbel – Ramses' Eternal Legacy

Morning:

Early departure with breakfast boxes

Private A/C drive to **Abu Simbel Temples**

visit:

Great Temple of Ramses II: Commemorates his victory at Kadesh (1247 BC) and features the first documented peace treaty

Temple of Nefertari: Dedicated to Ramses' beloved queen
