### **Ibn Tulun Mosque**

We'll continue to the **Ibn Tulun Mosque**, the oldest mosque in Cairo that has survived in its original form. Built in the 9th century, this vast and serene space reflects the grandeur of Abbasid architecture with wide courtyards and unique spiral minarets. It's a peaceful hidden gem in the city.

### **Al Muizz Street**
