learn about their fascinating history. You will have the opportunity to enter one of the pyramids (optional). However, your guide will not be permitted to join you inside. Alternatively, you can take a camel ride around the pyramids (optional).

After exploring the pyramids, continue your journey across the Giza Plateau for a stunning view of the pyramids from a distance. This breathtaking view is ideal for anyone who wishes to take memorable photos of this ancient wonder before visiting the Sphinx, often regarded as the symbol of Egypt.

Your next stop is Sakkara, home of Egypt's oldest pyramid, built in 2800 B.C. Your guide will provide a brief history of the famous Step Pyramid, and you'll have free time to walk around. Your final stop is Memphis, the ancient capital of Egypt. Here you will see artifacts from many of the great rulers of Egypt, including the fallen statue of Ramses II and the second-largest Sphinx in Egypt. You will also have the chance to visit a Papyrus Institute to see how the famous artwork is made.

Lastly, we are heading to the richest museum of all time! Welcome to the Grand Egyptian Museum. It's one of the world's largest and most impressive archaeological museums. Which is officially opened in July of 2024, it houses a vast collection and filled with treasures. There we will witness a monumental tribute to Egypt's rich and storied past. You will notice that it's situated near the Giza Pyramids, this architectural marvel is one of the largest and most impressive museums in the world.
