From its elevated position within the Citadel, enjoy breathtaking panoramic views of Cairo, with the Pyramids of Giza visible in the distance on clear days.

Next, visit the historic **Mosque of Ibn Tulun**, one of Cairo's oldest and most well-preserved Islamic monuments. Admire its distinctive architectural features, including the unique spiral minaret and expansive courtyard. Within the mosque's compound, you may explore the **Gayer-Anderson Museum**, a beautifully preserved house offering a glimpse into 17th-century domestic life.

The tour continues to the magnificent **Mosque-Madrassa of Sultan Hassan**, a monumental 14th-century complex. Marvel at its soaring arches, intricate stonework, and splendid multi-chromatic marble flooring—a testament to Mamluk architectural grandeur.
