Day 3

Temples of Kom Ombo & Edfu

Kom Ombo Temple – Dedicated to two gods, Sobek (the crocodile god) and Horus (the falcon-headed god). This temple is symmetrical, with twin entrances and halls.

Edfu Temple – One of the best-preserved temples in Egypt, dedicated to Horus. Explore its towering columns and detailed carvings.

Sail onward to Luxor while enjoying lunch, dinner, and the beautiful views of the Nile.

Day 4

Explore the Wonders of Luxor – Return to Hurghada

Karnak Temple – A vast complex with towering columns and sacred temples, dedicated to the gods of Thebes.
