### **Day 4**

#### **Coptic Cairo**

After touring Coptic Cairo, you will discover Islamic Cairo where you will visit the historic Fatimid era which is the gateway to the old city, mosques, houses, and palaces while passing through local markets.

#### **Fly to Luxor**

Fly to Luxor and board your dahabieh. Later, visit the Temples of Karnak, Luxor, and the Luxor Museum

### **Day 6**

#### **Valley of the Kings**

See the Valley of the Kings, Tombs of the Nobles, and well-preserved Tombs of the Workers. Sail to Esna

### **Day 7**

#### **Edfu**

Explore the Temple of Khnum, and sail to Edfu to view its temple, the best-preserved temple in Egypt

### **Day 8**

#### **Nubian Museum**

Sail to Gebel Silsileh to see the Temple of Horemheb. In Aswan, visit the Nubian Museum or the famous Spice Market

### **Day 9**

#### **Abu Simbel**

Fly to Abu Simbel, and explore two temples built by Egypt's longest-ruling pharaoh. Fly back to Aswan to visit the Temple of Calabash and the Temple of Philae

### **Day 10**

#### **Kom Ombo**

Head to Kom Ombo to discover the dual temple dedicated to the crocodile-god Sobek and falcon god Haroeris

### **Day 11**

#### **Tombs and Temples**

Explore less-frequented el-Kab, containing tombs and temples that date back to the early dynastic period

### Fly to Cairo

Fly to Cairo this morning, and spend the afternoon at leisure
