Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

Your Egypt Tours representative will meet and greet you at Cairo International Airport and assist you through passport control, the luggage area and customs formalities. After that, you will be transferred to your hotel in a private air-conditioned vehicle for check-in and overnight in Cairo, marking the beginning of your **4 day Egypt budget tour** to discover the wonders of Cairo and Giza.

Day 2

Giza Pyramids, Sakkara & Memphis

Cairo and Giza Uncovered in 4 Days begins with an incredible journey after breakfast at the hotel, stepping back in time to the days of ancient Egypt on a fantastic tour of the three [pyramids of the Giza Plateau](#)—one of the Seven Wonders of the World—built for the pharaohs Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. Then proceed to visit the [Great Sphinx](#) and the Granite Temple belonging to King Chephren. Afterwards, drive to Memphis and Saqqara, one of the most exciting historical and archaeological areas in all of Egypt. Visit the [Step Pyramid of Saqqara](#), the world's oldest major stone structure, built in the 3rd Dynasty for King Djoser. Continue exploring the Necropolis of Saqqara, including the Mastabas of Ti and Prince Ptahotep.

After that, transfer to [Memphis](#), founded by King Menes and known as the first capital of the Ancient Kingdom of Lower and Upper Egypt. Stop to see the Alabaster Sphinx and the remaining two colossal statues of Ramses II. You will also have the chance to visit a Papyrus Institute to learn how the famous artwork is made and see how names can be written in hieroglyphics. This memorable experience completes a wonderful day of your **Egypt tour package**.

Day 3

Explore Cairo city

As part of your **4-day Cairo and Giza pyramids budget tour** after breakfast at the hotel proceed to explore the [National Museum of Egyptian Civilization](#) accompanied by your knowledgeable Egyptologist guide.

This modern museum hosts a priceless collection encapsulating Egypt's history across several eras. Explore the Main Hall to examine countless artifacts demonstrating Egypt's development and cultural growth.

Continue to the Royal Mummy Hall where you will find an impressive display of 22 mummies of the great pharaohs of ancient Egypt. Among this stunning collection you will see the remains of Ramses II and Queen Hatshepsut.

Then continue to explore the ancient sites and culture of Coptic Christians as you visit Abu Serga, where the Holy Family sought refuge and Ben Ezra, one of the oldest synagogues in Cairo. Learn about Christian life in Egypt and discover the [Citadel of Salah el-Din](#) home to the impressive Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque.

Finally continue to [Khan el-Khalili Bazaar](#) and enjoy free time to stroll through its maze of streets, trying your luck bargaining with shop owners for a memorable souvenir of your trip to Egypt, completing another unforgettable day of your **Egypt budget tour**.
