The Unfinished Obelisk: A fascinating insight into ancient stone-working techniques. This gigantic obelisk, still attached to the bedrock, cracked during its carving and was abandoned. It shows the scale and ambition of ancient engineers.

Afternoon:

Visit the **Aswan High Dam**, a modern engineering feat powering Egypt's progress.

The High Dam: An engineering marvel of the 20th century that created Lake Nasser. It's a quick stop for panoramic views and to understand its profound impact on Egypt.

Day 5

Abu Simbel Day Tour

Continue onward to **Edfu**, where you will explore one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt, dedicated to Horus. This day offers a deep dive into ancient mythology and temple architecture.

Day 7

Luxor's East & West Bank Tour, Return to Cairo
