Day 1

Cairo (Arrival)

Morning:

Midday:

Visit the **Grand Egyptian Museum**, home to one of the most extensive collections of ancient Egyptian artifacts. Housing tens of thousands of pieces, the museum offers a journey through Egypt's long and fascinating history. With your Egyptologist guide, focus on the most important highlights and masterpieces spread across its various halls.

After the guided tour, enjoy **free time** to explore further at your own pace.

Evening:

Khan El Khalili Bazaar: Lose yourself in the vibrant alleys of Cairo's most famous market, where merchants have traded for centuries.

Bargain for souvenirs, explore hidden shops, or relax with Egyptian tea at the historic **El Fishawy Café**.

Day 3

Luxor (East Bank) (Karnak Temple & Luxor Temple) | Nile Cruise

Morning:

Check out from your **Cairo hotel** and transfer to **Cairo Airport** for your flight to **Luxor**.

Upon arrival, meet your representative and transfer via **air-conditioned vehicle** to your **5-star Nile cruise**.

Complete check-in formalities and enjoy a **welcome lunch** on board.

Afternoon:

Feluca Ride: Glide around **Elephantine Island** on a traditional wooden sailboat, soaking in Nile breezes and views of Aswan's botanical gardens and Nubian villages.

Evening:

Return to your cruise for a **farewell dinner** and **Nubian-themed entertainment** (optional).

Overnight on board, docked in Aswan.

Day 7

Abu Simbel – A Masterpiece Reborn | Return to Cairo

Pre-Dawn Departure:

Begin early with a **scenic flight or private drive** (your choice) from Aswan to **Abu Simbel**, traversing the Sahara's golden sands as the sun rises.

Morning: Abu Simbel Temples

Stand in awe before the **Great Temple of Ramses II**, its **four colossal statues** (each 20m tall) guarding the entrance. Your Egyptologist brings the site to life with tales of:

The **Battle of Kadesh** (depicted in vivid reliefs).

The temple's **astronomical alignment** (illuminating the inner sanctum twice yearly).

Its **miraculous 1968 relocation**—a UNESCO feat to save it from Lake Nasser's waters.

Admire the **Temple of Nefertari**, a rare tribute to a queen, adorned with scenes of Hathor and Ramses' love for his favorite wife.

Note: Guides cannot enter the temples, but you'll explore their interiors independently, marveling at the well-preserved carvings.

Midday:

Return to **Aswan Airport** for your flight to **Cairo**.

Upon arrival, be greeted and transferred to your **Cairo hotel**.

Evening:

Enjoy **free time** to relax or explore Cairo's vibrant nightlife (ask your guide for recommendations).

Overnight in Cairo.
