Day 1

Arrive to Cairo

Our representative will warmly meet and assist you upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, guiding you smoothly through passport control, luggage claim, and customs formalities. Afterward, you will be escorted to your hotel in a private air-conditioned vehicle, ensuring a comfortable and stress-free start to your **9-day Egypt family holiday to Cairo, Luxor, Aswan, and Hurghada**.

Overnight: in Cairo.

Day 2

Pyramids of Giza and the Grand Egyptian Museum

After finishing breakfast at the hotel, prepare for your thrilling [day tour of Cairo](#). Join up with your driver and guide and accompany your family to admire the fantastic [Pyramids of Giza](#), which have stood proud for over 4500 years and continue to inspire awe in the hearts of their visitors from across the world.

Afterward head to the [Grand Egyptian Museum](#); home to one of the world's greatest collections of ancient antiquities. Wander through the treasure-filled halls and admire the artifacts that bring Egypt's rich history to life. You will have plenty of time to explore (approximately 3 hours at the Pyramids and 3 hours at the museum) making this day a highlight of your **Egypt family adventure**.

In the evening you will board an overnight train to the southern city of Aswan (approximately 13 hours) continuing your unforgettable journey through Egypt.

Day 3

The Packed Bazaar and Unfinished Obelisk

Arrive in Aswan in the morning, where the Nile runs deep and fast between ancient granite rocks as the golden desert stretches toward the riverbanks. Even in ancient times, Aswan was known as the legendary gateway to the Kingdom of Nubia. Today, it remains a fascinating frontier town where the Arab Middle East meets Africa, a cultural highlight of your **9-day family adventure in Egypt**.

Visiting the packed bazaar is highly recommended in [Aswan day tours](#) ; you'll find exotic spices, carpets, leather goods, and countless other wares there. Enjoy the sights of donkey carts and men in flowing robes and turbans. In the afternoon, there may be time to visit the Temple of Isis at Philae (optional).

There are many other sites to be seen around Aswan, and your Egyptologist will organize some excursions for you, a camel ride or a trip to the [Unfinished Obelisk](#).

In the evening, you will take a trip across the river to a [Nubian village](#) and enjoy dinner at one of the local houses.

Overnight: in Aswan.

Day 4

Temples of Abu Simbel and Felucca

Rise for an early visit to the magnificent [Temple of Abu Simbel](#). Later in the day, you and your family will board feluccas (traditional wooden boats with broad canvas sails) to spend a day on the Nile River and enjoy your night under the stars. Watching the sunset aboard our

Egypt Nile Cruise is unforgettable, and this part of the **Egypt Family trip** will be highlighted.

Your Nubian sailing crew on the Felucca will prepare all meals. While there's no cabin or enclosed section on the Felucca, a canopy offers shade and protection from the elements. Conditions are basic, and you will sleep outside on the deck on a mattress. While blankets are provided, a sleeping sheet is recommended. There is a very clean toilet on board. During the colder months (October to March), it can get very cold at night (as low as 5C). This traditional sailing experience is a memorable highlight of your **Egypt family holiday tour**, offering a peaceful night under the stars along the legendary Nile River.

Overnight: aboard the Felucca.

Day 5

Kom Ombo in Aswan & Head to Luxor

After a delicious breakfast on board the Falucca, you will visit the [Temple at Kom Ombo](#). The temple is indeed dedicated to two gods: Haroeris (Horus the Elder) and the crocodile-headed Sobek, the Egyptian god of the Nile. Check out the many mummified crocodiles on display, a highlight of your **Egypt family holiday tour**.

On the East Bank around Kom Ombo, reclaimed land is fed by canals to keep the desert at bay. It supports not only crops of sugar cane but also a large Nubian community displaced from their homeland by the rising waters of Lake Nasser.

Transfer by bus to Luxor (approximately 4 hours), tracing the path of the Nile northward. Upon arrival, you'll have the chance to explore the

town's mesmerizing monuments and museums. For those who wish to experience the magic of history in a unique way, there is also the option to witness the breathtaking sound and light show at [Karnak Temple](#) (optional tour extra), making it a memorable moment on your **9-day family adventure in Egypt**.

Overnight: in Luxor

Day 6

Valley of the Kings and Temple of Queen Hatshepsut

After breakfast at the hotel, our driver and expert guide will take you to the ancient tombs of the pharaohs in the [Valley of the Kings](#), a highlight of your **Egypt family holiday tour 9 day**. Rise early to cross the Nile and journey to this secluded valley, where 63 pharaohs were laid to rest as part of their passage to the afterlife.

With your knowledgeable guide, explore some of the exquisitely decorated tombs of these ancient rulers. Among them is the famous burial site of the boy-king Tutankhamun; discovered by British archaeologist Howard Carter in 1922. This visit brings to life much of what you have already seen at the Egyptian Museum. If you wish to enter [King Tut's tomb](#), arrangements can be made in advance—ask your guide for details.

On your return to the Nile, stop at the funerary [temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#), Egypt's first female ruler, spending about an hour

exploring this remarkable site. The afternoon is yours to relax or explore Luxor at your own pace enjoying the comforts of your hotel or the nearby attractions as part of your **Egypt family tour package**.

Overnight: in Luxor.

Day 7

Temple of Karnak and Head to Hurghada

Early this morning take a horse-drawn carriage to the historic [Temple of Karnak](#); where you will explore its magnificent halls and towering pillars with our expert guide. The Karnak Temple stands as perhaps the most impressive of all the monumental works of the ancient Pharaohs making it a highlight of your **Egypt family holiday tour**.

In the afternoon bid farewell to the Nile and drive east to Hurghada. The lush green of the Nile Valley gives way to the barren expanse of the Eastern Desert. As you pass through rocky hills, the sparkling waters of the Red Sea come into view with the rugged Sinai Peninsula rising in the distance. Hurghada; a vibrant beach resort- offers a unique blend of relaxation and adventure and snorkeling here provides the perfect way to conclude your day. This experience is a memorable feature of your **family-friendly tour package**.

Day 8

Offshore Reefs in Hurghada
