Day 1

Welcome to Egypt

Greetings! We cordially welcome you and your family to Egypt and the beginning of your **Egypt family holiday** for Teens. Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, you will be greeted and transported to your

designated hotel for check-in. The rest of the evening has been kept free for you to indulge in your personal pursuits and relaxation.

Day 2

Giza Plateau, Sakkara and Djoser's Step Pyramid

Home to one of the world's first great civilizations, Egypt is brimming with ancient wonders, and today we will discover some of its most impressive sites as part of our **Pharaohs Adventure for Teens**.

Our first stop will be at the Giza Plateau, which contains the famous [Giza Pyramids](#) and the [Sphinx](#) statue. The architectural marvels of this site still confuse archaeologists today, so visitors should try camel rides to experience its attractions at their best.

We travel to the [Saqqara](#) necropolis after leaving the pyramids, which contains numerous sand-covered temples and ancient tombs and the [Djoser Step Pyramid](#) site. The train station will be our destination later this evening, where we will begin our overnight journey to Luxor by sleeper train.

Day 3

Luxor Arrival and Temple of Luxor Lightshow

Upon arrival in Luxor, we transfer to the hotel for check-in. Considered to be one of the most important archaeological sites in the world, ancient Thebes, known today as Luxor, will be our base for the next

two days as part of the **Pharaohs Adventure for Teens**.

Today, there is free time to kick back and relax, and later in the evening, there will be an optional excursion to the Temple of Luxor, included in our [Luxor Day Tour](#). Already impressive during daylight, the temple takes on a magical glow after dark as it becomes illuminated by a thousand colored lights (book and pay locally). Spend the rest of the evening at your leisure.

Day 4

West Bank and East Bank

Today your guide and driver will be waiting for you at your hotel to start your **family adventure** exploring the West Bank of the Nile as part of the **Pharaohs Adventure for Teens**. This area is home to the famed [Valley of the Kings](#), a vast and ancient necropolis marking the burial place of pharaohs from the New Kingdom period. The first stop will be at the [Colossi of Memnon](#), a towering pair of statues that are all that remains of the Temple of [Amenophis III](#). Your tour will continue in the Valley of the Kings and on to the [Valley of the Queens](#), the site of the imposing colonnaded temple of Queen Hatshepsut.

Crossing back over to the East Bank, we will return to our hotel for some free time before heading to [Karnak Temple](#). More than a temple, Karnak is a spectacular complex of sanctuaries, pylons, and obelisks built on a grand scale. Karnak was the most important place of worship during the height of Theban power.

Later this evening, we will return to Cairo by overnight sleeper train.

Day 5

the Grand Egyptian Museum

We arrive at Cairo in the morning and we go to our hotel for check-in. The [Grand Egyptian Museum](#) tour begins after we take time to refresh ourselves. The museum displays the largest collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts that exists in the world. During our visit, discover legendary treasures like the priceless artifacts of King Tutankhamun, including his iconic golden death mask, and other royal masterpieces, all included in our **Pharaohs Adventure for Teens**, offering an unforgettable **family tour adventure**.

The remainder of the afternoon is free for you to do any last-minute shopping or sightseeing.
