Abu Simbel

Awe-inspiring temples of Abu Simbel are the real symbol of the might and ambition of Pharaohs. With an Egyptologist guide, we will let out their intriguing past and real legacy.

Both the Temple of Ramses II and the smaller [Temple of Hathor](#) are huge rock temples carved into the side of a mountain during the 13th century BC, built by [Pharaoh Ramses II](#) in memory of his victory at the Battle of Kadesh as well as to intimidate the neighbouring Nubians.

Due to the Aswan High Dam construction and the resulting creation of Lake Nasser, the temples were relocated in 1968 to avoid being submerged. Today the Abu Simbel Temples are included in the “Nubian Monuments” UNESCO World Heritage Site. With our experienced guide, you will explore the temples and discover the secrets of their construction. Learn about their rediscovery in the 19th century and marvel at the stunning artwork and inscriptions that adorn their walls.

After your personalized tour of Abu Simbel you will return to Aswan by flight where you can reflect on your unforgettable **luxury tour** through the heart of ancient Egypt.

Day 7

The Temple of Philae

Take a scenic motorboat ride to the [Temple of Philae](#), beautifully set on an island in the Nile and dedicated to Isis, the goddess of health, marriage, and wisdom. Considered one of the legendary burial places of Osiris, the island was a deeply sacred site for the Ancient Egyptians. As part of your refined **Egypt luxury tours package**, you will explore this enchanting sanctuary where monuments from different eras—ranging from the Pharaonic period to the Roman Caesars—blend harmoniously in one spectacular setting.

The temple consists of monuments from various times extending from the Pharaohs to the Caesars. On a camel ride to the southern tip of [Elephantine Island](#), you will find St Simeon's Monastery, an ancient, abandoned fortress mostly built during the 7th century and located near Aswan. The monastery was given the name St Simeon by archaeologists and travelers. Still, earlier Arabic and Coptic sources called it Anba Hedra, after an anchorite who was consecrated a bishop of Syene (now Aswan) by Patriarch Theophilus (385-412 AD).

Day 8

The Edfu Temple

In the morning your Nile cruise continues to Edfu,- where you will explore one of the most remarkable highlights of your **luxury tour in Egypt**. The [Temple of Edfu](#), dedicated to Horus the falcon god, is the best-preserved ancient temple in the country. Built during the Ptolemaic period between 240 and 57 BC, its towering pylons, detailed reliefs and sacred chambers offer a vivid glimpse into ancient rituals and mythology. After your guided visit, return to the ship and relax on deck as you sail toward Kom Ombo, enjoying the serenity of your elegant **Egypt luxury vacation**.

We will visit the Ptolemaic [Kom Ombo Temple](#). It was built during King Ptolemy V's reign (ca. 205 to 180 BC). The Ptolemies constructed the Temple of Kom Ombo to worship the two gods, Sobek – the crocodile god, and Horus – the falcon god. After visiting the site, we will return to the ship for dinner and continue sailing north.

Day 9

Luxor Attractions

As part of your unforgettable **luxury tour in Egypt**, you will begin sightseeing on Luxor magnificent East and West Banks. This extraordinary city was dedicated to Amun one of the most revered deities of the Egyptian pantheon. Discover the Karnak Temple complex, with its towering columns, sacred shrines and impressive obelisks then continue to the elegant Luxor Temple, beautifully aligned along the Nile. After lunch cross the river to the West Bank.

The [Valley of the Kings](#) served as the royal cemetery for 62 pharaohs and remains one of Egypt's most treasured archaeological sites. You will visit some of the most famous tombs, including King Tut tomb. Head to the [Valley of the Queens](#) to take in stunning views of the tomb of Queen Nefertari; known for its vibrant and beautifully preserved wall paintings.

You can return to the cruise ship in the afternoon and spend some time relaxing. Stretch out on the deck, facing the serene Nile landscape while enjoying your comfort and elegance to the fullest and make your **Egypt luxury trip** totally unforgettable.

Next, venture to [Sakkara](#), the main graveyard of the Old Kingdom era and a renowned archaeological site, as part of your exceptional **Egypt luxury tour package**. Here, the legendary architect Imhotep built

Egypt's oldest stone pyramid—the [Step Pyramid](#)—over 4,800 years ago. This pioneering structure, composed of massive stone steps, marked a revolutionary advancement in royal tomb construction.
