Sobek's Temple used to house captive crocodiles, and many mummified specimens can still be seen at The Kom Ombo Crocodile Museum. As the day progresses, savor a spectacular Nile sunset from the deck of your luxury cruise ship as you continue south toward the vibrant city of Aswan.

Later, visit the vibrant souk in the heart of Aswan and pick up some souvenirs.

### Abu Simbel - Cairo

The Temple's inner chamber is illuminated by the sun's rays twice a year, during the Abu Simbel Sun Festival, casting a golden light on the seated statues of Ramses and two sun gods.

The Temple was relocated and rebuilt at a higher elevation during the construction of the Aswan High Dam. After your visit, enjoy a delectable lunch before flying back to Cairo. Spend the evening

relaxing at your luxurious hotel.
