Giza Pyramids, and Grand Egyptian Museum

Explore the Giza plateau and marvel at the Great [Giza Pyramids](#) and [Sphinx](#), dating back over 4600 years. Although there are over 100 pyramids in Egypt, the Giza Pyramids is one of the ancient Seven Wonders of the World. You'll even have the opportunity to enter one of the pyramids on your own (at additional cost), providing a once-in-a-lifetime experience.

Day 3

Memphis and Sakkara

Sakkara was the main cemetery of the Old Kingdom era. It is an amazing archaeological site where the famous and multi-titled architect Imhotep built the oldest pyramid in Egypt. The first stone structure is 4800 years old and was erected in the form of massive solid steps on top of each. (The name [Step Pyramid](#) is quite suitable). You will learn through these **luxury tours** about the complex step pyramid and the development of the royal tomb structure.

Your tour guide will accompany you inside one of the nobles' tombs in [Saqqara](#) (the tomb of Kagmini) and the tomb of Ti to see murals reflecting daily life activities in ancient Egypt. Moreover, you can enter the pyramid of Titi, where you can see the oldest form of the pyramid text on the chamber walls (4340 years old).

Memphis is your second destination to visit the open-air museum of the city. In [Memphis](#), you will see the second-largest Sphinx in Egypt, known as the alabaster Sphinx, the lying colossus of Ramses II, which

is a masterpiece and strong proof of how Egyptian sculpture reached its peak. You will also see many more monuments dug in this great city. The first capital city of Egypt was Memphis after the unity of the Southern and Northern kingdoms. Enjoy all the beautiful monuments on display in the open museum.

After having lunch, you will head to the airport for your flight to Luxor to continue your Best **Egypt luxury vacations 15-day** adventure.

Karnak Temple

Within the complex, you will find the great "Hypostyle Hall," which is an incredible forest of giant pillars. The Ptolemies constructed the Temple of Kom Ombo to worship the two gods, Sobek – the crocodile god, and Horus – the falcon god. After visiting the site, we will return to the ship for dinner, and then we will start sailing south towards Aswan as part of one of the finest **luxury tours in Egypt**.
