Luxor West Bank & Head To Edfu

functioned as the burial ground for various pharaohs during the New Kingdom period between 1570 BC and 1050 BC which lasted from the 18th to the 20th dynasty.

In honor of the heavenly heritage and accomplishments of [Queen Hatshepsut temple](#), This impressive structure, carefully crafted by hand, stands as a testament to the unparalleled beauty and grace of the queen, and serves as a reminder of her significant contributions to Egyptian society during her reign from 1507 BC to 1458 BC.

The enduring sentinel, the [Colossi of Memnon](#), has been keeping watch over the priceless treasures of ancient Egypt since 1350 BC. These magnificent statues, erected during the reign of Pharaoh Amenhotep III (1386 - 1349 BC) stand as a testament to the power and grandeur of the ancient Egyptian civilization. Return to the cruise and Sail to Edfu.

Day 3

Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples | Head to Aswan

After savoring a scrumptious breakfast, go on a journey to explore the majestic “Temple of God Hours,” the [Edfu Temple](#), during your **Egypt Nile River Cruise for 5 day**. This awe-inspiring symbol of power and victory was dedicated to the sky falcon god Horus and stands tall on the west bank of the Nile River. The magnificence of this temple lies in its immense size and quality of preservation, standing as one of the largest and best-preserved temples in Egypt.

After you complete this enriching experience; return to your luxurious cruise, which will continue until you reach the magnificent “house of twin wonders,” the [Kom Ombo Temple](#). This unique architectural site was constructed to honor Haroeris, “Horus the Elder,” and Sobek, the crocodile god of the Nile, and was built between 180 BC and 47 BC.

As the day draws to a close return to your cruise and indulge in a delectable lunch and dinner. Depart in the evening for Aswan and sail on the serene waters of the Nile; enjoying a peaceful night on Cruise.

Aswan (High Dam, Unfinished Obelisk & Philae Temple)

One of the most awe-inspiring feats of engineering in the world the Aswan High Dam was constructed between 1960 and 1970 to revolutionize the economy and culture of Egypt.

Next you will gaze upon the [Unfinished Obelisk](#) of Queen Hatshepsut; you can not help but marvel at the unparalleled architectural prowess of ancient Egyptians. This mammoth structure, intended to adorn the entrance of the Karnak temple complex was abandoned due to a catastrophic crack in its granite bedrock.

The mystical [Philae Temple](#) of Isis built in 280 BC by King Ptolemy II brings visitors into a realm of magical enchantment and mythological

legends. The majestic temple complex features exceptional sculptures depicting the Osiris myth.

After your unforgettable tour, return to your **Egypt Nile River Cruise**. You'll spend the night on board the luxurious vessel, enveloped in the tranquil ambiance of the Nile River.
