### Day 1

#### Arrival

Begin your journey with our **10 day Nile cruise with Cairo tour**.

Arrive in Cairo, where our team will meet and assist you at the international airport of the sprawling city of the pharaohs. Check in to

your hotel amid lush gardens overlooking the Great Pyramids of Giza.

## Day 2

### The Grand Egyptian Museum

As part of your **10-day Nile cruise with Cairo tour**, this afternoon visit the [Grand Egyptian Museum](#), where the treasures of Tutankhamun, along with artifacts dating back to 4000 BC reveal Egypt artistic and architectural heritage. Marvel at the treasures of [King Tutankhamun](#), dating back to 1352 B.C. and immerse yourself in the rich history of ancient Egypt.

## Day 3

### Giza Pyramids

As part of your **10-day Cairo and Nile cruise**, tour the [Giza Pyramids](#), home to the Pyramids of Menkaure, Khafre, and the Great Pyramid of Cheops, the only survivor of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Explore the [Great Sphinx](#) of Giza, guardian of the royal tombs from the third millennium BC, and immerse yourself in Egypt's timeless legacy.

## Day 4

### Luxor

Begin your day as part of your **Egypt Nile River cruise**. Go on your cruise for a journey to the magnificent [Karnak Temple](#). Walk through the Great Hypostyle Hall, its massive, expertly aligned columns a sight to behold.

After lunch, tour the [Valley of the Kings](#), where over 60 magnificent tombs from the pharaohs of the New Kingdom are carved into the desert rock. Explore the [Temple of Hatshepsut](#), ancient Egypt's first female pharaoh. You may also visit the Valley of the Queens (Biban

el-Harim).

## Day 5

### Dendera Temple

As part of your **Nile River cruise in Egypt**, cruise northward on a scenic route far from the crowds and other ships to the [Dendera Temple](#), among the best-preserved temples in Egypt. View the hypostyle hall, its roof featuring small shrines to Isis and Hathor nearly intact. Explore the interior chambers and underground crypt among foundations dating from the time of Cheops.

This afternoon, tour the [Luxor Temple](#), completed during the reign of Ramses II, and immerse yourself in the grandeur of ancient Egyptian architecture.

## Day 6

### Edfu & Kom Ombo

As part of your **Luxury Nile cruises in Aswan**, continue cruising to [Edfu Temple](#), dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed god. Built in 230 BC by Ptolemy III, this stunningly preserved structure reveals what temple worship in Ancient Egypt was like.

Later, disembark at [Kom Ombo Temple](#) (the Hill of Gold) to visit the Greco-Roman temple dedicated to Haroeris (the sun god) and Sobek (the crocodile god). Crocodiles were once found along this stretch of the Nile, and several of their mummies are now on display, offering a fascinating glimpse into ancient Egyptian beliefs.

## Day 7

### Aswan

The morning cruise travels to Aswan, from which we will board a motorboat to take us to [Philae Temple](#) on Agilika Island, where the temple was relocated and completely reconstructed through efforts to prevent flood damage after the [Aswan High Dam](#) construction. The tour proceeds to the renowned granite quarries, which contain the massive Unfinished Obelisk that displays the remarkable stone carving abilities of ancient Egyptian craftsmen.

During this **Nile River Cruise Package** end your day sailing around the Aswan islands in a felucca, enjoying serene views of the Nile and the picturesque surroundings (weather permitting).

## Day 8

### Abu Simbel

Leave your cruise and fly to [Abu Simbel](#), the site of the commanding temples of Ramses II and his wife Nefertari. Four enormous statues of the pharaoh dominate the façade of the former. Afterward, return to Cairo for a leisurely afternoon to continue your **Cairo and Nile River tour package for 10 day**.

## Day 9

### Cairo city

As part of your **10 Day Cairo tour and Nile Cruise**, after a relaxing morning, explore the [Mosque and Madrasa of Sultan Hassan](#). Built in AD 1356, it is one of the largest in the Islamic world and among the finest examples of early Mamluk architecture.

From here, walk from **Bab el-Fotouh** to [Khan el-Khalili Bazaar](#), where stalls display spices, leather goods, and jewelry. The street itself, running from the imposing, fortified Fotouh Gate to the Zuweila Gate,

has hardly changed in centuries. Bargaining is expected, so prepare to negotiate. Gather for a farewell dinner this evening, celebrating your unforgettable Egyptian journey.

## Day 10

### Departure

On your final day, check out of your hotel and board your international flight. Conclude your unforgettable journey with memories of ancient temples, majestic pyramids, vibrant bazaars, and a luxurious Nile experience.
