### Day 1

Cairo | Giza

Once you arrive at Cairo Airport, your guide will meet you and begin your tour with a visit to Egypt's famous pyramids. Seeing the pyramids is a childhood dream for millions of people around the world, especially those who learned about them at a young age.

With Your Egypt Tours, you will explore the Giza Pyramids and the Great Sphinx, the Step Pyramid of Saqqara, and the ancient capital of Memphis. Your day tour starts in Giza, where you will discover one of the most magical places in Egypt.

You will first visit the Great Pyramid of Cheops (Khufu), the only surviving wonder of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World and a powerful symbol of eternity. Built over 4,600 years ago, this masterpiece of ancient architecture will amaze you with its massive stone blocks, impressive height, and incredible age.

Your Egyptologist guide will explain the history of the entire area, including the pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus. You will have time to ask questions and enjoy free time for photography, including panoramic views of all three pyramids. You will spend more than two hours at the site, allowing time for optional activities such as entering one of the pyramid chambers or visiting the Solar Boat Museum (available upon request for an extra cost). You may also enjoy a camel ride around the desert area for an additional fee.

Next, you will move to the Sphinx area to explore this enormous statue, carved with the body of a lion and the head of a pharaoh, symbolizing strength and wisdom. Nearby, you will visit the Valley Temple, where you will learn about the ancient Egyptian mummification process.

Your tour continues to Saqqara, one of Egypt's most important archaeological sites. Here you will see the Step Pyramid of Djoser, the oldest stone pyramid in Egypt, built around 4,800 years ago by the famous architect Imhotep. You will also enter the Tomb of Kagemni, where wall paintings show scenes from daily life in ancient Egypt.

The final stop is Memphis, the ancient capital of Egypt. In this open-air museum, you will see the colossal statue of Ramses II, the second-largest sphinx in Egypt, and other impressive monuments from this historic city.

## Day 2

### **Grand Egyptian Museum & Old Cairo**

Explore the treasures of the Grand Egyptian Museum and look at amazing monuments and artifacts in its different halls on a guided tour. Although the museum has tens of thousands of artifacts in this short tour, your Egyptologist guide will focus on the highlights and masterpieces of the museum. Visit the Tut Ankh Amun Wing on the first floor and see his wonderful collection of historically important artwork. The treasures are mainly golden and they cover a quite large section of the museum. This area of the museum includes significant

statues, furniture, and gold sculptures. After enjoying the guided part of the tour, take some free time to browse the museum. Feel the relaxation of your soul when you go to Old Coptic Cairo. It is a very sacred and holy area as it contains 14 churches and a Jewish synagogue. The tour starts with a visit to the Hanging Church, one of the most beautiful churches that were built in the 5th century. Consecrated to Virgin Mary, The church was built above one of the towers of the fort of Babylon. It has 110 beautiful icons and once was the seat of the Patriarch. Your guide will explain to you all about the church before moving to the Cavern church or the church of St Sergius and Bacchus. Thousands of visitors come annually to this church to visit the cave where Jesus the baby and the Virgin Mary were hiding for 3 months during the journey of escape in Egypt. The religious tolerance in Egypt is embodied by your visit to the oldest Jewish temple in Cairo. This temple is one among the other 11 synagogues in Egypt and is named after a merchant from Jerusalem called Ben Ezra. You will be given the full history of the synagogue and the position of the Jewish community in Egypt. At the end of the tour, you will fly back to Luxor
