Continue to Al Alamein the site of the famous World War II battlefield, where you will visit the Military Museum and pay respect to fallen soldiers at the Commonwealth, German, and Italian cemeteries.

Your adventure then heads to the magical Siwa Oasis; where you will explore Shali Old Town, natural hot and cold springs, the salt lakes, and the vast Great Sand Sea. Enjoy the thrill of an [Egypt desert safari tour](#), enjoy camping in the Western Desert and discover authentic local life with a relaxing walk through the market to see traditional Siwan products.

Day 1

Alexandria

Take a fascinating **Alexandria, Al Alamein and Siwa Tour package** starting with a tour to Alexandria from Cairo in the company of Your Egypt Tours' Egyptologist guide. The second-largest city in Egypt, Alexandria has an atmosphere that is more Mediterranean than Middle Eastern and is famous for its Roman remains. With your Egyptologist guide to lead the way, you'll enjoy personalized attention on your tour of Alexandria. During the tour, you can determine the amount of time you'd like to spend at each of the sites you'll visit. Alexandria was founded by Alexander the Great in 332 B.C. and was the capital of Graeco-Roman Egypt.

Your first stop in this historic city is the [catacombs of Kom ash-Shuqqafa](#), a Roman burial site whose family tomb reveals the merging of Egyptian and Roman art and architecture. Descend below ground to visit the tomb and Caracalla Hall. Back above ground, continue to Pompey's Pillar, an 82-foot (25-meter) granite column built to honor Emperor Diocletian, who freed the besieged city and brought food to its starving people.

Continuing the Roman theme, the next site your guide will show you is the [Citadel of Qaitbay](#), built-in 1477 to protect the eastern side of the city. the fort was built in the same location as the great lighthouse of Alexandria. After lunch (additional cost) you will visit the famous Alexandria Library. In contrast to the ancient architecture found throughout Egypt, the Norwegian-designed building is a striking piece of modern design. A copy of every book published in the world is kept in the library, making it one of the great literary sites in the world. Overnight in Alexandria Note: The library of Alexandria is closed on Fridays and Saturdays.

Day 2

Al Alamein - Siwa

As part of your **Alexandria, Al Alamein and Siwa Tour package**, your guide will pick you up from your hotel in Alexandria at 06:00 AM, then drive to Alamein, about 3 hours' drive. At Al Alamein, you will enjoy the site where the great battle took place during World War II, and visit the WW II Museum and the cemeteries of the different rivals. Then drive on to the beautiful bay of Marsa Matrouh on the Mediterranean Coast to have lunch there. After that, continue to Siwa. It is about a 6-hour drive from Alamein to Siwa. Dinner and overnight in Siwa, preparing for your unforgettable **desert safari experience in Egypt**.

Day 3

Cleopatra Spring

Continuing your **Alexandria Tour package**, after breakfast, enjoy a visit to the Old City of Siwa (Shali). Then transfer to see the Alexander Temple at Aghurmi Village, traditionally linked to Alexander the Great, and dedicated to the God Amon from the 26th Dynasty, and then see Amun Ra Temple at Um Ubeyda. After that, head to visit Cleopatra Spring (Ein Guba). Finish your trip by seeing the Mountain of the Dead.

In the afternoon, transfer to enjoy the unique sunset in the Great Sand Sea and visit Bir Wahid, a natural hot spring. Stay the night at the campsite under millions of stars, enjoying an authentic **desert safari in Egypt**. Overnight in Siwa.

Siwa Attractions
