Day 1

Arrival

Day 2

Giza Pyramids & the Grand Egyptian Museum

After breakfast, enjoy an excursion to the great pyramids of Cheops, Chefren, and Mykerinus, and then proceed to the Sphinx and the Valley Temple.

Afterward, make your way to the Grand Egyptian Museum, Home to the world's greatest collection of antiquities, without equal. Wander the treasure-filled halls of the museum. The masses of gleaming artifacts recovered from the tomb of Tutankhamun are a remarkable sight. From gold jewelry to the famous golden death mask and his gilded sarcophagi, this pharaoh was certainly prepared for the afterlife.

Back to hotel and overnight in Cairo.

Day 3

Cairo

First, visit the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization. This modern museum hosts a priceless collection encapsulating Egypt's history across several eras. Explore the Main Hall to examine countless artifacts demonstrating Egypt's development and cultural growth.

Continue to the Royal Mummy Hall, where you will find an impressive display of 22 mummies of the great pharaohs of ancient Egypt. Then, continue to Salah El Din's Citadel and the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali before returning to your hotel for an overnight stay in Cairo.

Day 4

Alexandria Optional Tour

Free day in Cairo or an optional tour to the second capital of Egypt, Alexandria visiting Qaitbay Citadel, built in the 15th century by Sultan Qaitbay on the spot of Alexandria's ancient lighthouse. Move around and see the grand Montazah Palace, which combines Turkish and Florentine architectural styles, then move on to the new and much-acclaimed Alexandria Library. Also, visit the Roman cemetery cut out of the rock, the Catacomb. Return to Cairo overnight. Note: The library of Alexandria is closed on Fridays and Saturdays
