## Day 1

### Arrival

Your Egypt Tours representative will meet & greet you at Cairo International Airport, and handle your procedures through passport control, luggage area, and customs formalities. Then a private air-conditioned vehicle will transfer you to your hotel (with a pool). Overnight in Cairo.

## Day 2

### Pyramids, sphinx, Grand Egyptian Museum & Sakkara

After breakfast in the hotel, step back in time to the days of ancient Egypt on a fantastic tour of the three **pyramids of Giza plateau** one of the Seven Wonders of the World, Cheops, Chephren, Mycerinus, Then proceed to visit the **Sphinx**, and The Granite Temple which belongs to the king Chephren,

Next, the **Grand Egyptian Museum**, home to over 100,000 artifacts, including King Tutankhamun's treasures, where you can see the famed solid gold death mask of King Tutankhamun.

Thereafter, drive to **Sakkara**, one of the most exciting historical and archaeological areas in all over of Egypt. Visit the **Step Pyramids of Sakkara**, the world's oldest major stone structure. It was built in the 3rd Dynasty for King Djoser. Then proceed to visit the Necropolis of Sakkara, the Mastabas of Ti, and Prince Ptahotep.

## Day 3

### National Museum (NMEC) & Old Cairo

After breakfast in the hotel, proceed to visit Cairo's famous **National Museum of Egyptian Civilization**,

The NMEC is Egypt's and the Arab world's first museum to present the full breadth of Egyptian civilization—from prehistory to today—highlighting its continuity through tangible and intangible heritage. Its exceptional collection includes the royal mummies, displayed with cutting-edge interactive technology that reveals the secrets beneath the wrappings and explores ancient mummification rituals and beliefs.

Continuing to the ancient sites and culture of Coptic Christians, Visit Abu Serga, where the Holy family sought refuge, and Ben Ezra, one of the oldest synagogues in Cairo. Learn about Christian life in Egypt. In addition, discover the Citadel of Salah el-Din where Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque stands, continuing to Khan el Khalili Bazaars. Enjoy free time to stroll through the maze of streets and try your luck bargaining with the shop owners for a souvenir of your trip to Egypt.
