Day 1

Arrival

Your Egypt Tours representative will meet & assist you at Cairo International Airport, and handle all your procedures through passport control, luggage area & customs formalities. Then you will be transferred to your hotel and overnight in Cairo.

Day 2

Giza | Pyramids & Grand Egyptian Museum

After breakfast, meet your guide and travel to the Giza Plateau to see the Pyramids and Sphinx. Explore the site up close, with the option to enter the pyramids for an additional fee. Enjoy panoramic views, stand before the Sphinx, and visit the Valley Temple to learn about mummification from your Egyptologist guide.

Next, discover the Grand Egyptian Museum and its impressive collection of pharaonic treasures. Your personal tour guide will introduce you to the museum's highlights before you explore at your own leisure.

Day 3

National Museum, Citadel & Khan el-Khalili

After breakfast, you will be driven to see the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization, accompanied by your knowledgeable Egyptologist guide.

This modern museum hosts a priceless collection encapsulating Egypt's history across several eras. Explore the Main Hall to examine countless artifacts demonstrating Egypt's development and cultural growth.

Continue to the Royal Mummy Hall, where you will find an impressive display of 22 mummies of the great pharaohs of ancient Egypt. Amongst this stunning collection of mummies, you will find the remains of Ramses II and Queen Hatshepsut.

Next, proceed to the **Citadel of Salah el-Din** to visit the magnificent **Alabaster Mosque**. Perched atop a limestone hill, this iconic Islamic landmark offers panoramic views of Cairo. Inside, your guide will illuminate the core principles of Islam and translate common prayers.

Your cultural exploration continues in the lively **Khan el-Khalili bazaar**. Lose yourself in its winding alleys, browse for unique souvenirs, and perhaps enjoy traditional tea at the legendary **El Fishawy Café**.

Day 4

Alexandria

Discover Alexandria's ancient underground and monumental treasures. Begin at the Catacombs of Kom el Shoqafa, a unique blend of Egyptian, Hellenistic, and Roman art. Descend a rock-carved spiral staircase to explore ornate 2nd-century tombs, sculptures, and sarcophagi.

Then, visit the Serapeum, an ancient temple dedicated to the god Serapis. See the site's iconic landmark, Pompey's Pillar, rising 27 meters above the temple ruins.

Next, explore the 15th-century [Qaitbay Citadel](#), a fortress dramatically built on the ruins of the legendary Lighthouse of Alexandria.

Finally, move on to the new and much-acclaimed [Alexandria Library](#), a modern marvel housing millions of books.
