## Day 1

### Welcome

Your **11-day Spiritual Egypt tour package** begins as your Egypt Tours representative meets and assists you at Cairo International Airport, handling all your formalities through passport control, the luggage area, and customs. After that, you will be transferred by a private air-conditioned vehicle to your hotel. Overnight in Cairo.

## Day 2

### Head to Aswan (High Dam & ancient temples)

Fly to Aswan, the southern city that is considered the origin of Chakra energy and home to Khnum, the chief god of Aswan, who was widely known as the god of creation. As part of your **inspiring Egypt meditation Tours**, you will feel the powerful spiritual atmosphere that surrounds this sacred city.

Visit [Philae Temple](#), which was carefully moved to its current location (around 500 meters from the original site) when the construction of the [High Dam](#) caused the surrounding Nile waters to rise. A short motorboat ride takes you to the island, where your guide will lead you on a walking tour through the temple before giving you free time to explore on your own. Dedicated to the goddess Isis, Philae Temple enjoys a beautiful island setting in the Nile and has been landscaped to match its original site. Its various shrines and sanctuaries celebrate the deities involved in the myth of Isis and Osiris.

Then continue your **Spiritual tour** to the Unfinished Obelisk in the granite quarries of Aswan, where much of the red granite used for

ancient temples and colossal statues was sourced. The [Unfinished Obelisk](#) still lies where it was carved after a crack was discovered while it was being hewn from the rock. Your qualified Egyptologist guide will explain how the obelisk was carved and why the crack caused it to be abandoned. At the end of the day, board your Nile cruise.

### Day 3

#### **Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples**

Set off from the Nile cruise and visit the famous attractions in both Kom Ombo and Edfu as part of your enriching **Egypt Meditation Tours** experience. The [Temple of Edfu](#) was dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed god and it is considered the most well-preserved among all ancient Egyptian temples. Your private guide will provide a detailed history of the temple and its magnificent reliefs, revealing the spiritual symbolism carved into its walls.

You will also visit the [Temple of Kom Ombo](#) one of the most unique temples in Egypt and a meaningful stop on your **Spiritual tour in Egypt**. This extraordinary temple was dedicated to two Egyptian deities: Horus with the falcon head and Sobek with the crocodile head. It features two separate entrances, one for each god, reflecting its dual dedication. Beautifully located on a high mound overlooking the Nile, the temple offers visitors a stunning panoramic view of the river. It is believed that both temples are powerful energy centers connected to the ancient Chakra system.

### Day 4

#### **Karnak , Luxor temples & East Bank**

Explore the East Bank of Luxor to see two of the most impressive temples in Upper Egypt Karnak and Luxor as part of your inspiring

Ancient mysteries and **meditation Egypt tour package**. This remarkable day is one of the spiritual highlights of your Egypt Meditation Tours, blending history, sacred architecture, and powerful ancient energy.

Start your day with a visit to the [Temples of Karnak](#). Walk along the Avenue of Sphinx to enter the complex as your guide explains how the massive façade was constructed. As you step inside the Temples of Karnak you will witness the legacy left by generations of pharaohs. The deeper you go, the further back in time you travel, with some ruins dating back more than 3,000 years. Upon walking through the Great Court into the Great Hypostyle Hall, it is impossible not to feel awe beneath the 134 towering columns rising like an ancient stone forest.

You will also have the chance to experience the magnificent energies of healing while walking through the seven doors of the Temple of Sekhmet. At the rear of the complex lies the sacred lake, where centuries ago pharaohs and their offerings to the gods were purified, adding another profound dimension to your **Spiritual tour in Egypt**. After the guided tour, you will have additional free time to explore the vast complex at your own pace.

Continue to [Luxor Temple](#), which was once connected to Karnak by a 2-kilometer-long Avenue of Sphinx, part of which still marks the temple's grand entrance. Dominated by statues of the great warrior pharaoh Ramses II, Luxor Temple has survived Nile floods, foreign invasions, and thousands of years exposed to the elements. A pure example of Egyptian temple architecture, its inner walls and columns are covered with intricate hieroglyphics that your guide will help you decipher. Discover how Alexander the Great inscribed himself into the temple's history, and see one of the original pair of obelisks — the second now standing in the Place de la Concorde in Paris.

## Day 5

### Free day

Enjoy a free day in Luxor to relax and unwind at your hotel. Take advantage of the hotel amenities, reflect on the powerful experiences of your **Egypt Meditation Tours and Spiritual**.

## Day 7

### Dendara

Combine a morning in Dendara where you can visit the Temple of Hathor, before continuing for an afternoon of sightseeing in Abydos, home to "The Cult of Osiris" It is a place where most ancient Egyptians would have made a pilgrimage at least once in their lifetime. It is connected with the Heart Chakra, The approach path to the Temple of Hathor is between two Roman fountains that end at the massive entry gate. Hathor was the goddess of pleasure and love and was generally shown as a cow, or woman with a cow's head. The enclosure walls are mud-brick and date to the Roman era. Within the walls are the temple, two birth houses, a Coptic Basilica, a sanitarium, a sacred lake, and the Temple of the Birth of Isis. The temple has a long history with evidence that Pepi I (Old Kingdom) rebuilt the temple, while other texts refer to reconditioning by Thutmose III, Amenhotep III, and Rameses II and III (New Kingdom). Additions were made during the Greek, Roman, and Ptolemy periods. Abydos in Middle Egypt is an ancient holy place and burial ground of the rulers of the late prehistoric proto-kingdom, as well as the first attested kings of the politically unified Egyptian state. Buildings constituting the settlement

area in northern Abydos dating back to Predynastic times have been found around Kom es-Sultan, while recent excavators have found an Old Kingdom residential area to the south-east which contains a street of mudbrick houses with courtyards and a faience workshop with its kilns. Abydos is home to "The Cult of Osiris" the god of the dead. It is said the head of Osiris was buried at the site after he was murdered by his brother.

## **Day 8**

### **Back to Cairo**

Fly back to Cairo and check in your hotel in Cairo.

## **Day 9**

### **Giza pyramids**

After breakfast, Discover the magic of the great pyramid and explore the famous Giza pyramids area and Sphinx. You will start visiting the symbol of the Eternity and the only wonder that still survives among the seven wonders of the ancient world, the Great Pyramid of Cheops (Khufu). It is certainly one of the most important monuments of ancient Egypt. A masterpiece of fabricated structure and architecture, you will be overwhelmed by the huge size of its blocks, the height, and the age that exceeded 4600 years.

While you stare at this great monument which is the front Chakra, your guide will explain fully the history of the area including the other pyramids, of Chephren and Mycerinus, answer all your questions, and give you free time for photography. You will spend a long time in the area so that you can have enough time to enter the chamber of the great pyramid. This is the crown Chakra

From inside the Valley temple we will inter a shortcut to the Sphinx. Moving to the Sphinx area where you will spend some time exploring this monolith statue, which symbolizes the power and wisdom of the pharaoh as the statue, was carved as a lion's body and the head of the pharaoh. Next to the Sphinx area, you will visit the valley temple where you will learn about mummification in ancient Egypt. After lunch, we will have the chance to visit one of the centers of the essential oil in the area. Overnight in Cairo.

## Day 10

### **the Grand Egyptian Museum, Citadel of Salah el-Din Khan el-Khalili**

Today you will immerse yourself in Egypt's history with a visit to the famous Grand Egyptian Museum. Following this, you will visit Cairo's most popular Islamic attraction: the Alabaster Mosque, and then stroll through the Khan el-Khalili bazaar. Begin your journey surrounded by over 50,000 Egyptian artifacts, including the world's most extensive collection of Pharaonic treasures. Among the highlights is the priceless collection of **King Tutankhamun**, featuring his legendary gilded coffins and breathtaking golden mask. Your expert guide will lead you through the museum's masterpieces and then allow you time to explore at your own pace.

Following your visit to the (GEM), you will tour the Alabaster Mosque at the Citadel of Salah el-Din, which sits on top of a limestone hill overlooking Cairo and is the most important mosque in the city. The lower part of the Mosque is clad inside and out with Alabaster while the top part is constructed from the limestone cladding removed from the Pyramids of Giza. Inside the mosque, your guide will introduce you

to the basic beliefs of Islam, including a translation of the most common prayers.

Then you will discover the ancient sites and culture of Coptic Christians where you will learn about Christianity in Egypt. You will first visit the Hanging Church is built into the walls of the Watergate of the Roman fortress and is possibly the oldest Christian church in Egypt. Dedicated to the Virgin Mary, it is one of Cairo's most beautiful churches. Continue to the Monastery and Church of Saint George. It is one of the few remaining circular churches in the Middle East.
