## Day 1

You will also have time to walk around the vast pyramids complex, so comfortable shoes are recommended. During summer months, temperatures can be high, so be prepared with sun protection and water.

Continue the tour to the [Grand Egyptian Museum](#) in Cairo, one of the most important cultural highlights of any Egypt tour package. The

museum exhibits an exceptional collection of ancient artifacts which includes the invaluable Tutankhamun treasures. The collection which includes both detailed gold jewelry and the famous golden mask of the young king demonstrates the advanced skills and religious beliefs of ancient Egyptian culture.

This unforgettable day combines history, culture and discovery; making it a key part of your Egypt women tours experience.

### Day 3

#### Head to Alexandria

After breakfast travel in a private air-conditioned vehicle along the scenic desert road to Alexandria, the beautiful Mediterranean city often called the Bride of the Mediterranean. The [Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa](#) which serve as the largest Roman burial site in Egypt, become your first exploration destination after your arrival. The underground tunnels lead to a network of burial sites and passageways which showcase the artistic styles of both Egyptian and

Greco-Roman cultures.

The [Bibliotheca Alexandrina](#) stands as a contemporary tribute to the ancient Library of Alexandria and contains millions of books together with various cultural exhibits. The Corniche walk provides a peaceful experience which ends at the [Citadel of Qaitbay](#) that stands at the location of the ancient lighthouse.

End your day with a peaceful visit to Montaza Palace Gardens, where lush greenery and royal architecture create a perfect coastal escape, reflecting a truly **private Egypt women tour itinerary 12 days** experience.

## Day 4

### **Al Montazah Palace**

## Day 5

### **Aswan ( Elephantine Island & white-sailed feluccas )**

Visit the magnificent [Temple of Philae](#), which serves as a shrine dedicated to the goddess Isis. The temple complex was relocated to Philae Island because the original site needed protection from Nile waters, which now stands as one of Upper Egypt most significant archaeological sites.

You have free time to explore the Nubian Museum, which displays the complete history together with the artistic traditions and cultural heritage of Nubian people.

The evening presents a special cultural experience through a visit to a [Nubian village](#), which provides you with the opportunity to meet a local family and share their authentic dinner experience. The program enables visitors to experience local life through traditional activities and customs authentic to the area.

## Day 6

### Abu Simbel

This morning, take a short flight (approximately 45 minutes) from Aswan to [Abu Simbel](#), where you will explore some magnificent temples (flights not included)—built by Ramses II. It was the gateway to Egypt for Southern Africans, and its imposing facade delineated the line between what was the Pharaoh's land and what was not with the four gargantuan statues of Ramses guarding the Great Temple, carved directly out of the mountain on the west bank of the Nile. This is one of Egypt's most memorable sights, making it a highlight of any **Queen Nefertiti Egypt tour package for women**.

Return from Abu Simbel and transfer to meet your Nile cruise boat. Enjoy a fantastic mix of total relaxation and organized sightseeing on an iconic Nile River cruise to Luxor. At some point today, you will have the opportunity to enjoy the river from a felucca, a traditional Nile sailboat.

## Day 7

### Kom Ombo Temple

Continue your leisurely cruise down the Nile, with today's stop at [Kom Ombo Temple](#), north of Aswan. It was built on a high dune overlooking the Nile, the complex sits picturesquely ruined on the river's edge and dates back to the early 2nd century BC. The complex is unique because it has a mirror-image design, divided down the middle, with

either side dedicated to a different set of Gods, making it an essential stop on your **Egypt tour with a Nile cruise for solo women**.

One-half is known as the Temple of Sobek (the crocodile-headed god of fertility), and it includes details on the Ancient Egyptians' relationship with crocodiles, whom they revered and feared in equal measure. The other half is dedicated to Haroeris (also known as Horus the falcon God). In addition, the whole temple is full of fascinating reliefs.

Return to the cruise boat where you'll continue traveling upriver. With free time relaxing on the sundeck. Then take in the surrounding sights desert hills forming a backdrop to lush riverbanks. Fishermen casting their nets and farmers working their land.

## Day 8

### Edfu Temple

Today you arrive at Edfu home to one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt, dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed god. You will disembark and explore the energetic streets of Edfu town which includes its main square and its authentic market area. The group will move to The [Temple of Edfu](#) which stands as the most complete ancient temple in Egypt.

The temple presents a magnificent appearance through its massive dimensions which feature towering sandstone walls that display detailed reliefs and hieroglyphic inscriptions. The grand entrance leads visitors into an expansive courtyard which contains 32 enormous columns that display intricate ancient carvings.

As you continue exploring you will discover detailed reliefs that show both ritual practices and sacred offerings dedicated to the gods Horus and Thoth. The atmosphere creates a deep sense of awe which connects people to the historical legacy of the past.

Return to your cruise boat for your final night aboard the cruise while you enjoy the peaceful views of the Nile River during your **12-day Queen Nefertiti tour with the Nile cruise for women** experience.

## Day 9

### Luxor ( Karnak Temple & Valley of the Kings )

Your Nile cruise ends in the open-air museum of Luxor from the spectacular temple complex of Karnak to the [Valley of the Kings](#). Luxor is full of wonderfully preserved reminders of the Pharaohs, making it a key highlight of your **Queen Nefertiti tour with a Nile cruise for solo women**.

Today you will visit the magnificent [Karnak Temple](#) Complex, which is perhaps the most impressive of all the ancient Pharaohs' monumental works. One of the world's most celebrated temple complexes. Karnak is a house of the gods built over some 200 years.

Your guided tour of this vast temple of impressive pylons, obelisks, and chapels will reveal its finest sections, such as the Avenue of Sphinxes and the Great Temple of Amun. The rest of the day is free for you to relax, then shop in the excellent bazaar (open until quite late) or perhaps experience the atmosphere of a local teahouse.

## Day 10

### Colossi of Memnon & Valley of the Kings

Today you will hop in a private minivan and discover some of the many wonders of ancient Thebes, continuing your unforgettable **tour to Queen Nefertiti for women** experience.

Your first stop is the [Colossi of Memnon](#), two 17-meter-high statues on Luxor's west bank. Carved from granite blocks, they represent the Pharaoh Amenhotep III and were once part of an impressive colonnade.

Continue to the spectacular royal burial site of the Valley of the Kings. Buried under the arid hills here are over 60 tombs of pharaohs, many richly decorated with reliefs and paintings. With your leader. Explore this sprawling and spectacular place. Where the pharaohs of the New Kingdom (16th to 11th century BC) secretly interred for all eternity.

Your group leader will explain the history and legends of these remarkable people and their funerary rites. Moreover, the significance of the many paintings and hieroglyphics is still well preserved in the deepest tombs.

You will visit three of the most interesting royal tombs and then continue to the [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#). A stunning colonnaded building set against high cliffs creates a spectacular natural amphitheater. One of our Egyptian great queens; built this temple to prove her importance among her ancestors.

The afternoon is yours to explore. Perhaps you would like to shop in the market. Alternatively, visit the world's first Mummification Museum to discover the secrets of pharaonic preservation.

## Day 11

### Cairo Islamic parts

Catch a short flight back up to Cairo this morning (approximately 1.5 hours).

On your return to the capital. Visit the Islamic parts of the city. In addition, the frenetic backstreets of the local bazaar (Khan el-Khalili) with your trip leader. A labyrinth of narrow streets and passageways, Khan is one of the biggest and oldest markets in the world.

The 'Khan'. Sprawling around an old area known as Al-Azhar is a quintessentially Cairo experience. A warren of alleys with stalls serving up a succession of intoxicating scenes. It retains a distinctly medieval feel. You might explore the gold market.
