Day 1

Arrival at Aswan

Your **4 day Amoura Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Aswan to Luxor** starts here. You arrive in Aswan. One of our staff is waiting for you. Then your Egyptologist guide takes you straight to [Philae Temple](#) – beautiful carvings, old stories, and a goddess named Isis who still feels present.

After Philae, you visit the [High Dam](#). Big wall. Controls the Nile. Powers half the country. Then a break from history. You walk through the Aswan Bazaar. Spices, scarves, small shops, nice people. Lunch is nearby – fresh and tasty.

After lunch, you board the Dahabiya. We sail toward [Kom Ombo](#). The river is wide here. The sky feels big.

We stop for the night near Kom Ombo. Dinner on board.

Overnight: Onboard The Nile Cruise | **Meals:** Lunch, Dinner.

Day 2

Kom Ombo

As we reach Kom Ombo on your **Amoura Dahabiya Cruise from Aswan to Luxor**, you'll step onto land to explore the Greco-Roman Temple – a true testament to ancient building skills. The temple is

perfectly balanced with two entrances, two halls, and two sanctuaries. One side belongs to Haroeris (the falcon god), the other to Sobek (the crocodile god).

Then, something special. We tie up right next to the Speos of Horemheb – a small rock-cut temple tucked away along the riverbank, quiet and hidden.

If the weather is good, dinner happens right there. You eat next to an ancient temple. If not, we move to the upper deck of the Dahabiya.

Overnight: Onboard the Nile Cruise | **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 3

Edfu

Start your day at your own pace with a filling breakfast on your **Amoura Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Aswan to Luxor** as we head to the grandeur of [Edfu Temple](#), one of Egypt's largest and most intact monuments. A horse carriage ride takes you to the entrance, where two magnificent granite statues of the Falcon God Horus stand sentinel.

After your temple visit indulge in a unique shopping experience at the bustling bazaar. As the Dahabiya sets sail, a picturesque island becomes the backdrop for a memorable dinner.

Get ready for an Egyptian evening of fun as you dress in your bespoke Gallabeyah or belly dancing outfit. The boat transforms into a haven of cultural celebration as we sail gently to Esna.

Overnight: Aboard the Nile Cruise | **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4

Luxor's Eastern Bank

It's the last day of your **4 day Amoura Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Aswan to Luxor**. You start early. There's a lot to see.

First the [Valley of the Kings](#). You walk into tombs cut deep into the mountain. The colors on the walls still look fresh after 3,000 years.

Then [Hatshepsut Temple](#). Three floors carved into the cliff. It doesn't look like any other temple in Egypt. A queen built this to touch the sky.

Next the [Colossi of Memnon](#). Two giant statues sitting alone in a field. They've been watching the sun come up since before Rome was born.

Last stop [Karnak Temple](#). Big. Huge. You walk through halls of columns that feel like a forest made of stone.

Then you go back to the Dahabiya. Say goodbye to the crew. Take one last look at the Nile.

The cruise ends here. But the stories? You carry those with you.

Meals: Breakfast.

Day 1

Arrival at Luxor – Esna

Your **5 day Amoura Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Luxor to Aswan** starts the moment you land.

A Your Egypt Tours representative is at Luxor International Airport to welcome you. Then you meet your Egyptologist guide – the person who will bring the old stones to life.

Together, you explore the West Bank:

[Valley of the Kings](#) – tombs cut into the mountain, built for eternity

[Hatshepsut Temple](#) – a queen's dream carved into the cliff

[Colossi of Memnon](#) – two giants sitting in the field, watching time pass

[Karnak Temple](#) – huge columns, sacred halls, stories everywhere

After a full day of history, you leave Luxor behind and drive to Esna.

That's where your Dahabiya waits.

You board in the evening. Dinner on board. Overnight in Esna.

Meals: Lunch, Dinner.

Day 2

Edfu

As the sun touches the Nile with its golden hues on your **5 day Amoura Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Luxor to Aswan**, start your day with a scrumptious breakfast.

The boat sails gracefully toward Edfu. You arrive at the ancient city where the majestic [Edfu Temple](#) awaits one of Egypt largest and most complete monuments. A horse carriage ride takes you to the entrance. Two giant granite statues of Horus, the falcon god, stand on each side. They've been welcoming visitors for thousands of years.

After the temple, you come back to the **Luxuey Dahabiya Cruise** for lunch.

Then the boat sets sail again, gliding slowly along the Nile quiet waters. You watch the scenery change – palm trees, small villages, farmers working the land.

Next stop: Silsela Hormoheb Temple. A hidden gem. Most tourists never see this place.

If the weather is nice, dinner is there, right next to the old stones. If not, you eat on deck. Either way, the evening is special.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 3

Kom Ombo

Set the tone for a day of discovery and relaxation with a good breakfast on your **Amoura Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Luxor to Aswan**.

As the boat sails toward [Kom Ombo](#), the excitement builds. The temple sits right on the riverbank – Greco-Roman, different from the others. Two gods live here: Sobek the crocodile and Haroeris the falcon. The guide will walk you through it. The stories are worth hearing.

After the temple, you keep sailing toward Aswan. This is where the Nile slows down and shows off.

As the sun drops the boat finds a quiet spot to moor near the edge of Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4

Aswan - High Dam and Philae Temple

As we get close to Aswan on your **5 day luxury Amoura Dahabiya Nile Cruise Luxor to Aswan**, take in the gorgeous Nile waves as they rush by the boat.

Enjoy your lunch while you prepare to say goodbye to your Dahabiya – not yet, but soon.

After lunch, your tour begins. You'll visit:

The [High Dam](#) – a massive wall that tamed the Nile

The [Philae Temple](#) – beautiful, quiet, sitting on its own island

If there's time, you can also walk through Aswan's Bazaar. Spices, scarves, friendly shopkeepers. A nice break from temples and history.

After the tour, you come back to the boat. Relax. Watch the river one more time.

Dinner is served on board. Overnight in Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 5

Farwell

On your final day of the **5 day Amoura Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Luxor to Aswan**, you say your farewells, enjoy breakfast, and reflect on your unforgettable journey on the Dahabiya Nile boat.
