Day 1

Arrival at Aswan

You arrive in Aswan. We head straight to the sights: the massive [High Dam](#) and the [Unfinished Obelisk](#), still lying where ancient carvers left it thousands of years ago.

Then, we take you to your **4 day Sacred Lotus Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Aswan to Luxor**. A small, beautiful boat that feels like home. Lunch is served as soon as you step on board. Hot food. Cold drinks. The Nile right outside your window.

After lunch, we raise the sails and drift toward Kom Ombo. The scenery is quiet. The water is calm. You'll feel the stress of everyday life disappear with every passing minute.

We stop for the night near Kom Ombo.

Day 2

Kom Ombo – Edfu

We start the day with breakfast on your **Sacred Lotus Dahabiya Nile Cruise Aswan & Luxor**.

First stop: [Kom Ombo Temple](#), sitting right by the water. Two gods here Horus the falcon and Sobek the crocodile. Two doors. Two halls. You won't see this anywhere else.

Then we take a short walk to Gebel el Silsila. Old quarries. Small chapels cut into the cliffs. And here's the best part, we park right next to the Speos of Horemheb. You eat dinner there. Right next to a temple that's been here for thousands of years.

After dinner, we sail again. Next stop Edfu. We sleep on board, moving slow with the current.

Day 3

Luxor Top Attraction

We'll have a delightful breakfast and take in Luxor's attractions before embarking on our day. We will visit the Edfu temple, which is one of Egypt's well-preserved monuments.

Considering the weather, dinner will be served on the Sun Deck as we gently sail en route to Esna Overnight Esna.

Day 4

Luxor's Eastern Bank

You wake up on your **4-day Sacred Lotus Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Aswan to Luxor**. Last day.

Have a healthy breakfast. Then we go to the West Bank.

First, the [Valley of the Kings](#). Tombs cut deep into the mountain. Still colorful after all these years.

Then, the [Colossi of Memnon](#). Two big statues sitting in a field.

Nothing else around them. Just the giants and the sky.

Finally, [Hatshepsut's Temple](#). Three floors carved into the cliff. Looks different from any other temple in Egypt.

After that, we take you back to the Dahabiya. Time to pack up and leave.

Meals: Breakfast.

Day 1

Arrival at Luxor – Esna

Your **5-day Sacred Lotus Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Luxor to Aswan** starts when you land at Luxor International Airport.

A representative from Your Egypt Tours will be waiting for you. You'll go together to visit the West Bank.

You'll see the [Valley of the Kings](#), where the pharaohs were buried. You'll see the [Colossi of Memnon](#), two giant statues sitting in the open field. And you'll see the [Temple of Hatshepsut](#), carved into the mountain.

After that, you'll head to Esna to board your **Dahabiya Cruise**??????. Once you're on board, lunch will be served.

The rest of the day is free. You can relax on deck and watch the Nile. Dinner and overnight are on board in Esna.

Meals: Lunch, Dinner.

Day 2

Edfu

You start the day with a delicious breakfast on your **Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Luxor to Aswan**. As the boat moves gently toward Edfu, you can sit back and watch the river. The views are peaceful. Palm trees. Villages. Farmers working the land.

When you arrive in [Edfu](#), a horse carriage is waiting for you. It takes you to one of Egypt's largest and best-preserved temples. The entrance is guarded by two giant granite statues of Horus, the falcon god. They've been standing there for thousands of years.

After the temple, you come back to the boat for lunch. A good meal. Then you sail toward Silsela Hormoheb Temple.

The evening is quiet. Dinner is served on board. You sleep on the water.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 3

Kom Ombo Temple

Start your day with a good breakfast as your **Sacred Lotus Dahabiya Nile Cruise** sails toward [Kom Ombo Temple](#).

This temple is different. It sits right on the riverbank and belongs to two gods – Sobek the crocodile and Horus the falcon. Your Egyptologist will walk you through it and show you the small details you might miss on your own.

After the temple you keep sailing toward Aswan. The Nile is calm here. You can hear the water moving gently against the boat. A soft breeze helps cool the air.

It's the kind of quiet that makes you slow down and just breathe.

As you get close to Aswan, dinner is served on board. You eat while the city lights start to appear in the distance.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4

Aswan - High Dam and Philae Temple

Your **5-day Sacred Lotus Dahabiya Nile Cruise Luxor & Aswan** is coming close to the end.

As you approach Aswan, the Nile moves a little faster. You can see the waves passing by the boat. Enjoy your meal and start saying goodbye to the Dahabiya – slowly.

After breakfast, your tour begins. You'll see the [High Dam](#), a massive structure that changed the Nile forever. Then you'll visit [Philae Temple](#), sitting on its own island, beautiful and peaceful.

You'll also have time to walk through Aswan's Bazaar. Spices. Scarves. Small shops with friendly people.

Lunch is served on board or nearby. After that you can relax. No rush. Just sit and watch the river one last time.

At night, enjoy a hearty meal and breathe in the lovely Aswan air. It's

warm, soft, and unforgettable.

Day 5

Farwell

On your last day of the **5-day Sacred Lotus Dahabiya Nile Cruise from Luxor to Aswan**, you wake up slowly.
