Day 2

Day 3

After an abundant breakfast, we go to the renowned Kom Ombo. As may be observed, there are two temples. Horus the Elder, also known

as Haroeis, the Falcon God, is honored with a temple. The Crocodile, Sobek, the cosmic creator and fertility deity, represents the opposing side. Enjoy a fantastic supper, fascinating historical sights, and a thrilling evening to cap off an outstanding day.

Day 4

Aswan - High Dam and Philae Temple

The gorgeous Nile waves swish by us as we get closer to Aswan. As you prepare to say farewell to your journey, enjoy your lunch.
