The enduring sentinel, the **Colossi of Memnon**, has been keeping watch over the priceless treasures of ancient Egypt since 1350 BC. These magnificent statues, erected during the reign of Pharaoh Amenhotep III (1386 - 1349 BC), stand as a testament to the power and grandeur of the ancient Egyptian civilization. Return back to the cruise and Sail to Edfu.

Day 3

Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples | Head to Aswan

This awe-inspiring symbol of power and victory was dedicated to the sky falcon god Horus and stands tall on the west bank of the Nile River. Its grandeur lies in its immense size and remarkable preservation, making it the largest and most intact temple in Egypt.

Following this enriching experience, return to your luxurious cruise and resume sailing until you reach the magnificent "house of twin wonders" - the [Kom Ombo Temple](#). This temple, a unique piece of architecture, was constructed to pay homage to the Haroeris or "Horus the Elder" and Sobek, the crocodile god of the Nile. Built between 180 BC and 47 BC.

As the day draws to a close, return to your cruise and indulge in a delectable lunch and dinner. At nightfall, set sail for **Aswan**, reveling in the tranquility of the Nile and spending a peaceful overnight onboard the cruise.

Aswan (High Dam, Unfinished Obelisk & Philae Temple)

Step into a world of enchantment and myth as you visit the mystical [Philae Temple](#) of Isis, built in 280 BC by King Ptolemy II. The grandiose temple complex is adorned with impressive carvings that tell the myth of Osiris.
