Unfinished Obelisk

Carved directly into bedrock, this massive obelisk—had it been completed—would have been the largest ever erected. A visible crack halted construction, but it still offers rare insight into ancient stoneworking techniques.

Philae Temple

Located on Agilkia Island, Philae Temple is a serene sanctuary dedicated to **Isis**, goddess of motherhood and magic. Built during the Ptolemaic period, it's one of Egypt's last temples, beautifully preserved and adorned with detailed reliefs portraying scenes from the myth of Osiris.

Pompey's Pillar

Finally, visit Pompey's Pillar—an imposing Roman column made of red granite, standing 27 meters tall. It was erected in the 3rd century AD in honor of Emperor Diocletian and remains one of Alexandria's most iconic monuments.

Return to Cairo.
