Seti I's magnificent limestone sanctuary.

Features the unique **Abydos King List**, a chronological record of 76 pharaohs

Afternoon:

Scenic lunch at a **Nile-view restaurant** in Luxor

Luxor West Bank Exploration

Valley of the Queens
